



# **ATMOSS6 Changes**

Version 1.0    09 December 2003

The latest version of ATMOSS (version 6) is targeted at improving useability and owner name searching. This document details the changes between version 5 and version 6. For assistance using the new version of ATMOSS please contact:

## **1 Getting Started**

### **1.1 Existing Customisation**

Any customisation you had set up in the previous version of ATMOSS will not be retained when the new version is implemented. Your extract list and list of searches will also be deleted.

### **1.2 Screen Settings**

ATMOSS6 has been designed to work best with a screen resolution of 1024 × 768. You can continue to use a lower resolution such as 800 × 600 but you may need to scroll more.

## **2 Navigation Pane**

The fundamental change in ATMOSS6 is the introduction of the navigation pane on the left hand side of the screen. Items in this pane replace the buttons at the top and bottom of the screen in the previous version. Using this pane you can navigate to any other ATMOSS screen without the need to scroll.

## **3 Terminology**

Some terminology has changed in the new version of ATMOSS. This new terminology is explained below:

### **3.1 Guest Access**

On the previous version of ATMOSS, you were able to log on to a Single Session Connection. This has been renamed, Enter as Guest but works in exactly the same way. The Multi-Session Connection button has been relabelled to Log On. If you wish to retain search results or customisation you should enter a name and password and select Log On.

### 3.2 My Search

If you customise the search criteria displayed on the Search Page, this search is known as My Search. You can still access the Basic and Advanced searches from the Search menu item in the left hand navigation pane.

### 3.3 My Details

If you customise the information displayed on the Trade Mark Details Page, this becomes known as My Details. You can still access the Summary and Full details from the Trade Mark Details menu item in the left hand navigation pane.

### 3.4 My List (Extract List)

The name of your Extract List has changed to My List. This is purely a change in the terminology used, creating My List is done in exactly the same way as the Extract List in version 5.

#### 3.4.1 Add Records to My List

Adding records to My List is very similar to the previous version. You can tick the check boxes next to the records you wish to add and then click the Add to List button located at the top and bottom of the Search Results page. If you wish to add all records to the list, place a tick in the checkbox at the top of the page and click Add to List. This will add all results on the page you are looking at. If your search results span more than one page, you will need to add records from each page.



#### 3.4.2 Removing Records from My List

When you view the My List screen, all records will be ticked, indicating they have been selected. To remove a record from My List, uncheck the corresponding tick box and click Delete Unticked.

### 3.5 Search List

The List Searches button in ATMOSS version 5 has been renamed to Search List in the latest version. Its operation has not changed.

## 4 Customisation

The amount to which you can customise your use of ATMOSS has been extended in the latest version. The major change is the ability to customise the search results page. You can choose to display owner name information in your search results. This is particularly useful if you are performing an owner name search. You can also choose how many search results to display per page.

Displaying Status (Low Level) will display the exact status rather than the broad groupings of pending, registered, never registered, etc.

A List Only option has been added to the Report Customisation. Selecting List Only will deliver an e-mail report that only contains the search strategy and list of trade marks. No abstract details are provided using the List Only option.

## 5 Trade Mark Number List

The TM Number List search criteria on the Search Page has been amended to accommodate a greater number of trade marks. This search field can be used to search on single trade mark numbers, a list of trade mark numbers or a range of numbers. Below are examples of valid entries in the TM Number List field:

## **6 Indexing Comments**

It is now possible to display indexing comments on the trade mark details page. You need to have Indexing included in your customisation (or be looking at the Full Details page) for the information to be displayed. Indexing comments are most frequently used to provide additional information on prohibited trade marks (those trade marks with a number less than zero).

## **7 E-Mail Report**

### **7.1 Searcher's Name**

To make identification of your reports easier, the name you used to log on to ATMOSS will display at the top of the first page of the e-mail report.

## **8 Name Searching**

Outlined below are the changes that have been made to name searching. As well as amendments to the rules relating to owner name searching, a new search type has been added allowing you to search on Opponents and Non-Use Applicants.

*Tip:* It is recommended that when searching on owner names you customise your Search Results Page to include the owner name.

### **8.1 Owner Name Searching - Opponents**

A new search type will be added allowing you to search on name of opponent and applicants for non-use.

### **8.2 Owner Name Searching - Noise Words**

It is not currently possible to search on noise words within owner names. Words such as AUSTRALIA, COMPANY, PTY cannot be searched. This makes searching for names such as THE AUSTRALIA COMPANY very difficult. In the new version of ATMOSS, all words within an owner name will be searchable.

### **8.3 Owner Name Searching - Single Letters**

It is not possible using the existing version of ATMOSS (or the mainframe) to search on single letters within an owner name. This makes it difficult to search on names such as Z-TECHNOLOGY. With the latest version of ATMOSS all elements within an owner name will be searchable. Following is a table outlining a number of owner name variations and the elements by which they can be searched.

All punctuation will be removed from owner names. Words and letters punctuated or containing either of the characters, "." "-" or "\_" will act to join elements.

## **9 Known Issues**

### **9.1 Mouse Scroll Wheel**

The scroll wheel on the mouse does not work to move up or down the page for certain internet browsers. It is still possible to scroll using the arrow keys, page up and page down and also by mouse clicking on the scroll bar.

### **9.2 Screen Printing**

When viewing an ATMOSS page, if you use the print icon located at the top of the page, not all details will print correctly. To overcome this problem, a Print Friendly Page button has been added to all affected pages. If you wish to print a screen, click on the Print Friendly Page button. A new window will open which has been formatted for printing. You can then use the Print icon at the top of the window to print the details.
