



Confirmation of submission of propagating material to a genetic resources centre (GRC)

Before grant of Plant Breeder's Rights can be made on an application, the *Plant Breeder's Rights Act 1994* states that propagating material of that variety must have been deposited for storage, at the expense of the applicant, in a genetic resource centre.

A quantity of propagating material of a plant variety that is lodged with a genetic resource centre must be sufficient to enable that variety to be kept in existence if there were no other propagating material of plants of that variety.

The person in charge of a genetic resource centre may do all things necessary to maintain the viability of propagating material stored at that centre.

The delivery and storage of propagating material of a plant variety does not affect the ownership of the material but the material must not be dealt with otherwise than for the purposes of this Act.

The propagating material of a plant stored at a genetic resource centre may be used for purposes of this Act, including the purposes of Section 19 (Reasonable public access to plant varieties covered by PBR).
