Part 1—Preliminary

1 Name

This determination is the *Trade Marks (Approved Means for Paying a Fee) Determination 2019*.

2 Commencement

Parts 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to that Act commence on 24 February 2019, unless proclaimed to commence earlier: see item 3 of the table in subsection 2(1) of that Act, after that Act received the Royal Assent on 24 August 2018.

- (2) Any information in column 3 of the table is not part of this determination. Information may be inserted in this column, or information in it may be edited, in any published version of this determination.

3 Authority

This determination is made under subsection 223AA(1) of the Act.

4 Definitions

In this determination:

Act means the *Trade Marks Act 1995*.

EFT means Electronic Funds Transfer.

EFTPOS means Electronic Funds Transfer at Point of Sale.

Part 2—Approved means for paying a fee

5 Approved means for paying a fee

For the purposes of subsection 223(2C) of the Act, the means for paying a fee are by:

- (a) credit card; or
- (b) accounts for selected services; or
- (c) cash, cheque or money order; or
- (d) EFTPOS; or
- (e) EFT; or
- (f) direct debit.

Note: The availability of payment methods may vary depending on the means of filing.

6 Preferred means for paying a fee

The preferred means for paying a fee are by:

- (a) credit card; or
- (b) direct debit.
